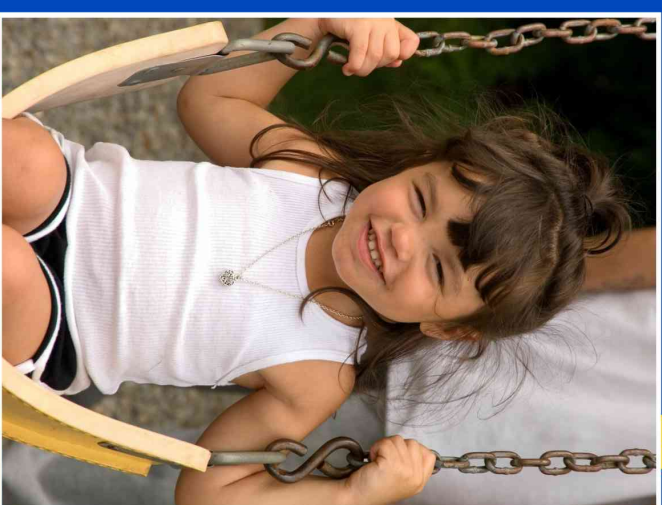

## **Family Promise is here to help!**

We provide a safe home like environment where families can be together and get the help they need to get back on their feet. We are a "hand up" program to help families break out of the homeless population.

Families get one on one attention from our staff social worker to connect with local services and establish goals and direction. Together we work to get families on track and moving towards permanent housing and a more stable lifestyle.



## **Family Promise is a community team!**

We partner with existing community resources to provide resources to each family to make sure the children and adults get the support they need. Our staff social worker is aware of all the resources in the valley and works to make sure each family is connected with the help they need.

Family Promise also relies on the support of businesses and individuals in our community to provide the financial resources necessary to keep this program moving forward. Our first five years have been a tremendous success and we are looking forward to the future!

## **Family Promise partners with a growing group of faith organizations!**



Currently, we have 11 Host congregations that provide sleeping space for our families on Family Promise portable bedding. They work together with 12 Team churches to assemble the volunteer teams that host the families at the churches and prepare the meals. This unique partnership allows us to provide a housing solution for families that cost much less than traditional government run shelters. In addition, we mobilize an army of over 350 volunteers in our community who serve together and help our valley be a great place to

## **Family Promise Day Center and Office**

Our Day Center provides a place for our families to call home during the day. We have shower and laundry facilities as well as internet access and a place to store some personal belongings. The Executive Director and the Social Worker both have an office there as well.

## **The need in our community continues to grow.**

We are all aware that the number of homeless continues to grow, current statistics reveal that to be true in our community. According to Clarkston School District 200 students were recognized as homeless in 2011-2012. In Lewiston schools the most recent numbers show 150 students classified as homeless. Those figures continue to grow and the most common situation is single moms with children under the age often.
